# Use of cookies by this website

cqc.org.uk	_ga cookie-agreed ki_s ki_t	CQC Cookies are used on websites that display the CQC widget in the bottom right side of every page. ki_s and ki_t ensure that you do not see a survey you have already completed again via the CQC website.
Universal Analytics (Google)	_ga _gali _gat_UA- <i>nnnn</i> - 1 _gid	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website. We may use the information to compile reports to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information including the number of visitors to the website, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited. UA-nnnn-1 'nnnn' represents the 8 digit UA number assigned by Google to this website.  Read Google's overview of privacy and safeguarding data

The SearchIQ cookies are used to remember in-site searches and search position. The 'cfduid' cookie is set by the CloudFlare service to identify trusted web traffic and to speed up page load times and the '_ga' cookie is used by GA to distinguish users.

All videos, such as YouTube and Vimeo, have their cookies disabled within the code, therefore they do not use any cookies.
